



RELEVANT EVENT

Chihuahua, Chihuahua, September 2nd, 2010 - Grupo Cementos de Chihuahua, S.A.B. de C.V. (BMV: GCC*) (the Company) informs that the Bolivian Government issued an ordinance reverting the sale of 33.34% of the shares of Fábrica Nacional de Cemento, S.A. to Sociedad Boliviana de Cemento, S.A. (SOBOCE) occurred in 1999. Grupo Cementos de Chihuahua owns 47.02% of the share capital of SOBOCE.

This event does not have a significant impact on the Company's cash flow, because the Company receives cash from the Bolivian operations only through SOBOCE's dividends. The effect, due to proportional consolidation of these operations, on the Company's sales and EBITDA, is between 8% and 10%, even though, as mentioned before, it does not have a significant effect on cash flow.

About GCC

GCC is a leading supplier of cement, aggregates, concrete and construction-related services in Mexico and the United States, and holds a significant share in Bolivia's largest cement company. The Company has annual cement production capacity of 5.0 million tons.

Founded in 1941, the Company's shares trade on the Mexican Stock Exchange under the ticker symbol GCC*.
